

## REMINDER: TRANSPORTATION PLAN SURVEY

The 2022-23 State Budget included additional funds that



school districts can receive to pay for more of the costs associated with providing student transportation services. In order to receive the funds, the District is required to adopt a <u>Student Transportation Plan</u> on or before April 1, 2023 after obtaining input from various educational partners.

The Student Transportation Plan is currently in development and will be taken to the Board of Education for approval at the March 21, 2023 regular meeting.
