In my continuing discussion of regular attendance at school, I wanted to update you on our goal for average daily attendance. We are striving for an average of 96.5% of students at school on any given day. This is a lofty goal, as our daily attendance rates have been significantly lower over the past few months.

For example, today's attendance percentage was 89.8%. That means over 10% of campus missed instruction today. In hard numbers, about 60 children weren't here. That's 60 children that will need to be caught up on what they missed. Our talented teaching staff is dedicated to meeting children where they are and growing them as much as they can. That becomes an extra challenge when they must pause in their work to address missed learning due to

absence.

Remember, we certainly don't want children who are sick at school. However, families can do their part by making attendance every day their priority as well. That means planning family events and outings on scheduled days off, moving appointments to before- or afterschool times, and coming for even *part* of a day when something can't be rescheduled.

We have amazing children who deserve to get the most out of their learning experience at Chet. Please help us make sure they are here to do it.


