Let me begin with a thank you for a successful first full week of school. Among all the things to celebrate, I want to especially thank you for the easy transition to saying our morning good-byes at the gates this week. We appreciate your understanding as we balance safety, security, and keeping our campus a welcoming place for our community.

To that end, I wanted to remind you that campus is open to visitors under certain circumstances. A visitor may enter campus for a brief time to complete a specific task. To enter campus, visitors must sign



in using our online system in the office. Visitors must have a valid photo ID with them. The system will create a visitors badge that must be worn on campus. When the visitor leaves campus, they must do so through the office and check-out using the same online system. Failure to use this system could mean losing the privilege of visiting campus.

Volunteers are different. Volunteers are on campus for longer periods of time and may work in classrooms. Since students are present, a volunteer must complete a Volunteer Application, including a basic background check. If you are interested in becoming a volunteer, the application is now online. You can complete it at this link: https://forms.office.com/r/kjvVvEtip3 You will also need to provide us with a copy of your photo ID. Directions on submitting your ID are included in the application. It takes up to two weeks to process a volunteer application and approve it.

Be advised that teachers and staff arrange schedules for volunteers that are shared with the office, and there is no "drop in" volunteering on campus. If you have questions, please email infocfh@santeesd.net.





This past week we experienced excessive heat, and it is forecast to continue next week. While we are expecting reasonable temperatures this week, I wanted to update you on our actions when high heat occurs.

First, we make an alteration to outdoor play. We take advantage of cooler morning temperatures for outdoor play and PE whenever we can. We encourage students to drink water and watch for any signs of students being overheated.

When temperatures begin to rise, we move indoors to take advantage of air conditioning, Classes may participate in an alternate PE activity such as learning about a sport or lessons on nutrition and healthy choices.

Lunch sometimes still takes place outdoors, but very differently. Students are in the shaded lunch area for less than 20 minutes. They are monitored, and their movement is limited to sitting and eating lunch. We also track the temperature in the lunch area. Typically, because of the shade and proximity to the trees in our Outdoor Learning Lab, it is 10-15 degrees cooler than other parts of

campus. Once eating time has ended (between 15 and 20 minutes) students are moved indoors to air conditioning.

Other times, lunch is eaten indoors. This has been the case during the past few days. Some grade levels eat in classrooms and some eat in the MultiPurpose Room.

Again, throughout the day we are looking out for each other, encouraging hydration, and taking it easy. High temperatures occur this time of year. With all indoor spaces air conditioned and the strategic use of outdoor spaces we can move through this weather safely.
