PARKING LOT REMINDERS



Now that we are getting into our routines, here are some basic reminders about our parking lot to keep things moving safely and efficiently.

When dropping off and picking up, please pull completely forward. Be careful not to stop across our crosswalk as you do so.

Please be sure your child is ready to leave the vehicle as soon as you stop for drop-off. Please make sure you pull away as soon as your child is safe and secure during pick-up. We want to keep traffic moving.

Children may only exit a vehicle that is in the lane adjacent to the curb. They should not exit vehicles in the middle or far left lanes.

Adults should NOT exit vehicles in the drop-off/pick-lanes. If children need assistance, consider parking and walking in together.

You may exit the drop-off/pick-up curb into the middle lane when it is safe, and you are ready to move on. You may NOT enter the curb lane from the middle lane. You may NOT pass vehicles in the drop-off/pick-up lane and enter in front of them. (You may not skip the line.)

If you are walking on to campus across the parking lot, you are expected to use the crosswalk.

All drivers are expected to follow the directions of Safety Patrol students and all staff members. Failure to follow directions may result in losing the opportunity to use our parking lot.

All drivers are expected to follow the directions of all posted signs. Please be sure not to ignore signs directing you to our drop-off/pick-up areas.

Keeping our patience and an observant eye are also keys to a safe parking lot. Thank you for all you do to make it a safe place for all.



## BOON SUPPLY FUNDRAISER GRADES 4-8

We have just begun our first fundraiser for students in grades 4-8. We offer at least two fundraisers for students in these grades each year to raise money for Sixth Grade Camp (grades 4-6) and Middle School Activities (grades 7-8). These fundraisers are designed so that money earned for the school is earmarked for individual

students. It's as if they have an account. <u>That said, all dollars</u> earned in these fundraisers are considered school funds. Therefore, fundraiser money cannot be withdrawn or refunded. It can only be used toward school-based events.

### More about Boon Supply:

Boon Supply is online only and offers a variety of things to buy such as reusable bags, gift wrap, popcorn, cookie dough, classes, magazines, and other miscellaneous items to buy. Forty per cent of each purchase goes into that child's account for 6th grade camp and/or 7th and 8th grade end of year activities. The products that are purchased will be shipped right to the purchaser's home. Additionally, a "boost" incentive will be given to each student that sends out 10 emails or shares to social media. As students sell items, there are additional prizes that will be sent to the office and will be distributed to students who earned prizes. Look books & parent handouts about the fundraiser were sent home with your child today.


